Timeouts do not carry over
14 minute halves U8/9/10
16 minute halves U11/12/13

Tournament Rules

Player Provisions

- Must be age-appropriate as of August 1, 2011 (ICBA exception rule applies)
- Must wear basketball or athletic shoes with non-marking soles
- Must not wear jewelry during the games

Team Provisions

- Maximum roster of 12 players; no double rostering
- Maximum of (2) adults on team's bench, including head coach
- Must have team shirts with numbers
- Responsible for own warm-up balls
- Report to gym at least 15 minutes prior to your game, game will start as scheduled if team has 5 players

All Divisions

- 2 full time-outs per half ; 1 additional time-out per overtime; no carryover
- Time stoppage in last minute of 1st and last 2 minutes of second half
- Coach may call time outs
- Player ineligible on 5th foul; shoot 1+1 on 7th team foul; 2 shots on 10th
- Technical foul = personal and team foul, automatic 2 points for opposing team
- 3 point shot where marked
- Players or coaches ejected will be ineligible for next game
- PIAA rules in effect unless modified by the above

8/9/10 Divisions

- 14 minute halves
- No full court pressing for 8U division until last two minutes of game
- No full court pressing for 9U and 10U divisions with 10 point or greater lead

11/12/13 Divisions

- 16 minute halves
- No full court pressing with 15 point or greater lead

Tournament Provisions

- Round-robin format
- Each team is guaranteed 3 games
- Pool winners based on won/loss record
- 1st tie breaker is based on head-to-head-results
- 2nd tie breaker is based on accumulated point differential for all games
- Game point differential is capped at 13 points +/- for wins & losses
- Pool winners play championship game for age division as their extra game
- 1st & 2nd place in 4&5 team brackets, without another pool, will play for championship
- Awards given to the winners of each age bracket
- Spectator admission = \$5 per day per adult (good at all facilities); children 14 & under free
- Concessions will be available at all facilities
- Trainer will be available for injuries, no preventive care will be provided
